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Processing

The processing and material temperature should be between 68-77°F (20-25°C).

For best results, de-air the material prior to casting. The hardener component will slightly darken as it ages. It is recommended that dry nitrogen be used to blanket the material to prevent oxidization and from becoming moisture contaminated. Care must be taken not to damage the metal seal when removing it from the hardener can. If the seal is punctured and then replaced, it will not sufficiently retain the nitrogen blanket. This will allow the hardener to oxidize and become dark. The cured material will also oxidize over a short period of time. This will cause the material to slightly darken in shade.
